

Objective: To host a cultural and community event on behalf of the Detroit Creative Society called "The Pieces of Detroit" that showcases a 2 part mural installation highlighting the 4 pillars that uphold our city; Community, Love, Teamwork, & Culture.


Event Details:

The 2 part mural consists of 4 3x3' freestanding wooden puzzle pieces, strategically placed in high traffic areas surrounding the Michigan Central Station. The areas are Newark and Vernor st, the FREC, Southwest Greenway, & Roosevelt park. The second mural is a large completed puzzle mural of the smaller 4 puzzle pieces together, placed at the Newlab outdoor space at Michigan Central Station. At each site, we will host different cultural experiences consisting of music, food, and entertainment that highlights the primary cultures in Detroit; Latino, African American, Arabic, and Irish.

Each puzzle piece will have a QR code that when scanned, will have information regarding the neighborhood, its history, information about the art/artists, and the positive impact of the project on the neighborhood. Maps will be available for participants to collect stickers from each event space that once completed can receive a gift bag at the Main Stage located outside of Newlab. DCS intends on collaborating with the Detroit Hispanic Development Corporation to provide free shuttle transportation to each activated space and collaborating with other organizations to build cohesion. This will increase public engagement and interaction while providing accessibility to our residence during the event and providing a platform for other organizations to share their important work with residents. This project celebrates the cultures that make Detroit whole while simultaneously uplifting and highlighting the incredible talent within our city. This is the mission of the event "Pieces of Detroit"
